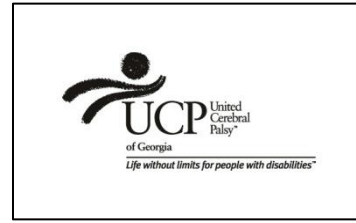

Sixteen models who have a variety of disabilities were selected in an audition process held by UCP of Georgia, in which nearly 100 individuals participated.

The event will be held at the Emory Conference Center Hotel on Saturday, February 11th, and will include a luncheon, a silent auction featuring Valentine’s Day gift and date packages, and other special touches designed to create a memorable holiday celebration.

“We are thrilled to be able to showcase people who have disabilities as our models,” said fashion show coordinator and personal stylist Shayla Smith. We want everyone to know that each of us has the capacity for our inner beauty to shine through, and that being fashionable is something every person can achieve, regardless of their age, body type or physical challenges.”
